ICIP Green Infrastructure Application

WHEREAS, Yellow Creek Waterworks remains non-compliant in meeting provincial drinking water due to high levels of Ammonia and Manganese.

WHEREAS, Eco Engineering Ltd. prepared a report on necessary upgrades to the waterworks to become compliant, as well to install a truck-fill station which will service the entire municipality with potable drinking water.

WHEREAS, in 2019 the RM applied to the *Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program* (ICIP) for an upgrade via the Melfort Rural Pipeline Association to the Yellow Creek Waterworks, but the application was not approved.

WHEREAS, the Melfort Rural Pipeline Association advised that at this time there is no existing capacity available to service the Yellow Creek Waterworks.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Invergordon, No. 430 support the application for an *Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP)* grant for the Yellow Creek Waterworks Upgrade Project,
