BE IT RESOLVED, that B&B Enforcement Services be appointed Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the RM of Invergordon for the year 2022, at a rate of \$39.74 per hour and \$0.45 per kilometer.

AND, that the appointment is limited to the enforcement of Animal Control Bylaw #2012-06 and Division 5: Dangerous Animals of *The Municipalities Act*, and shall be under the direction of Administrator Beaulieu.
