WHEREAS the Crystal Springs Recreation Co-Op has obtained a quote in the amount of \$5,612.86, including taxes and the gas permit, for the cost of the furnace replacement;

BE IT RESOLVED that Council approve a 50% cost-share of the furnace replacement at the Crystal Springs School, and that the Municipality contribute \$2,806.43 toward the total quoted cost as a gesture of support for the continued maintenance and operation of the facility.
